Advances in anaesthesia have made procedures safer, with low rates of anaesthetic complications. However, complications can arise due to pre-existing conditions that may not be evident during a physical examination. In order to better evaluate your pet's current health status, a pre anaesthetic examination will be performed by your veterinarian who will then ascertain the physical status of your pet or the "risk profile".

We highly recommend pre-anaesthetic blood screening as some disorders can only be detected by blood testing. This information indicates whether we need to take additional precautions or postpone the procedure pending treatment. These tests do not guarantee the absence of anaesthetic complications; however they provide vital information and potentially alert us to other medical conditions that may require future treatment. A normal result gives us a "baseline" for future comparisons.

We also highly recommend administration of intravenous fluids during procedures under general anaesthetic as this maintains blood pressure during the procedure and aids recovery. This also provides direct access should emergency medications be required. **Please mark X in appropriate box below.**

It will be necessary to clip or shave some hair from the front leg(s) and/or other areas. If your pet is being desexed a tattoo will be applied to the ear. Tooth removal may be necessary in some dental procedures. Patients will be monitored during and after anaesthesia. Pain relief and other medications will be administered in the hospital at the discretion of the veterinarian. Your pet may require medications to take home.

As owner or representative of the owner, I authorise the procedure and anaesthetic/sedation as agreed, and also the above testing and/or fluid therapy for my pet. I also agree to pay all fees in full on discharge of my pet.
